IAAMJV is a non-profit and tax exempt organization that was founded in 1991. It currently has 700 members - many of them are the alumni students of Shri Mahavir Jain Vidyalay in India. It also has strong support of many education loving individuals from the larger Jain community. It is one of very few organizations outside of India, which wishes to promote professional education in the Jain community.

The association offers three scholarship programs aimed at helping deserving students in the following categories: (1) Graduate students from India studying for master program in USA, (LSGI) (2) Undergraduate students residing in India (LSUI) and, (3) High School seniors/undergraduates residing in the United States (CEL). These scholarship opportunities are open to all Jain students, irrespective of their sect or region. All scholarships are in the form of interest free loan scholarships and are awarded with the expectation that they will be repaid once students have graduated. An overview of the programs follows below:

1) Loan Scholarships for Graduate Students from India for Higher Education in USA (LSGI)

IAAMJV offers loan scholarships of \$2,000 to bright and needy graduate Jain students from India who are studying in master program at graduate institutions in USA.

- ✓ \$847,000 worth of loan scholarships awarded to 426 students, since 1993.
- ✓ Most awardees earn graduate degrees at US institutions.
- ✓ The awardees are required to return their loan scholarships and have done so in many cases, making more funds available for current and future needy students.

2) Loan Scholarships to Undergraduates in India (LSUI)

IAAMJV offers loan scholarships ranging from Rs. 5,000 to Rs. 15,000 to bright and needy, undergraduate Jain students in India.

- ✓ **Rs. 64,70,000** /- worth of loan scholarships awarded to **640** students since 1993.
- ✓ Rs. 819,000 /- worth of scholarships are awarded to 75 students for current year of 2014.
- ✓ Few more additional awards are in process which will support more students..

3) US Students' College Education Loan Scholarships in USA (CEL)

IAAMJV offers \$2,000 for the first year and \$1,000 loans for rest of the three years to Jain high school seniors, who are attending American secondary institutions and are preparing to go to college for undergraduate study.

- ✓ This program has generated a great deal of interest in the Jain community in the USA.
- ✓ \$165,000 worth of Loan Scholarships awarded to 130 scholars (44 students) since year 2000.

For the betterment of our community and to preserve our rich heritage and culture, we would like to invite you to join us in this noble endeavor. By supporting the education of students, your participation will enable us to brighten the future of the next generation. We hope that these efforts will enhance the vibrancy of the Jain community as well as our shared global community.
