Tribute to Senior Scholarship Committee Members, Ahmedabad

We are very sorry to inform you that Arunbhai Bhavsar and Prof D. M. Shah passed away in Ahmedabad, India on the same day, March 20, 2017.

Late Shri Arunbhai Bhavsar:

Arunbhai was born in 1936 in Nadiad district and earned a B. E. degree from M. S. University of Baroda and stayed at MJV, Baroda. Subsequently, he taught at several colleges, last one being at Surat Polytechnic College. He was also active in the Shrimad Rajachandra Mission at Koba and involved with the publication of DIVYADHANI magazine. He started helping IAAMJV in 1993 and was active for close to 18 years with full support from his wife, Hansaben.

Late Shri D.M. Shah:

The life story of Prof D. M Shah is equally impressive. He was born in Rangoon in 1941. He received his B.E. degree from Nagpur in 1964 and M. Tech from IIT, Pawai in 1970. He taught at several colleges and worked as a Principal for many institutes as well. In spite of his busy teaching career, he opted to volunteer for IAAMJV beginning 1993 and did not stop till he became sick a couple of years ago. His wife, Dakshaben helped her husband regularly in carrying out the IAAMJV activities and is still continuing to help.

Both of these individuals were very dedicated and selfless workers and ran the IAAMJV scholarship operations diligently for close to two decades and made very important contributions. Through their efforts, hundreds of bright and needy students received scholarships paving the way for a better future. IAAMJV (India) is where it is today due to the sacrifices made by silent workers like Arunbhai and Prof D. M. Shah and their wives. Their loss will be felt by us for many years. We will miss them dearly.

Scholarships Reports

A. College Education Loans to Under Graduate US Resident Students (CEL)

College Education Loans to Undergraduate US Resident Students program was started in the year 2000 and since then we have given out loans to 46 students over the past 15 years. The program has 28 sponsors with total amount of \$134,000.

IAAMJV is looking revamping CEL program. Students are given total of \$ 5,000 over the four years of their undergraduate studies. Now we are changing to, \$3,000 in the first year and then \$ 1,000 for the next two consecutive years. We also plan to campaign for additional funds to see if we can increase the loan amount up to \$10,000 per student. Students repay their loans once they start their professional carrier. Students who have participated in this program have greatly appreciated the funds and support they have received. On-going loan repayment from graduated students has enabled IAAMJV to extend the loan amount.

B. Loan Scholarships to Undergraduates Students in India (LSUI)

The loan scholarship program started in 1993 for Jain boys and girls in India for pursuing undergraduate, graduate and special studies. We continue to receive large number of applications. Every year, we select about 75-100 students and award them with the loan scholarships ranging from Rs. 15000 to Rs. 25000 based on their merit and need.

The new committee under the leadership of Dr. Sunil Shah continue to make excellent progress. The scholarship committee meeting was held in presence of Jitendra Vora & Vasant Shah in February 2017 at the Dr. Shah's office. Most of committee members including Mrs. Rashmi Shah, Pankaj Shah, Madhubhai Doshi were present. We discussed many issues, improvement ideas & financial status. We are rolling out the new web portal for the students to apply online starting this year.

We awarded Rs. 67,07,000/- worth of loan scholarships to 697 plus students from year 1993 to 2016. We awarded loan scholarship to 77 students, amounting a total of about Rs. 13.20 lakhs.

C. Loan Scholarships to Students from India for Graduate Study in USA (LSGI) –by Mahendrabhai Shah

The LSGI Loan Committee has awarded 12 loan scholarships in spring-2017 semester. Since the inception of LSGI program, we have awarded Total of \$989,000.00 to 476 students. Those who graduated are now working and are doing very well. We are very fortunate to be in a position to help these students and see them prosper right in front of our eyes.



LSGI Scholarship Online Application Portal: We deployed this new online portal this semester- Spring 2017 and tested successfully. We received over 50% student loan applications through this portal. This portal will help us process applications in most efficient manner. Even more exciting news is that this portal is now connected to our main website; **“IAAMJV.ORG”**

Recipients with outstanding loans are requested to repay the loans as soon as possible so that other deserving students can get the advantage. LSGI Scholarship committee is trying very hard to contact students who are overdue in their loan repayment. Please keep scholarship committee informed if address or other information is changed for any of these students.

Endowment Fund USA (EFU) for LSGI

Under this scheme, a donor can donate \$50,000 for LSGI for one student and may designate a graduate student coming from India (from the list scrutinized and prepared by the LSGI Scholarship Committee). Donor will be informed about the award. We have received a total of \$450,000 and established nine (9) Endowment Funds – USA.

Gold Patron Fund (GoP) for LSGI

Under this scheme, a donor can donate minimum \$15,000 per fund. Scholarship committee will designate a student under this fund from the application pool. Donor will be informed about the award. When fund of \$15,000 is depleted, the award will be recycled after loans are repaid by the student.

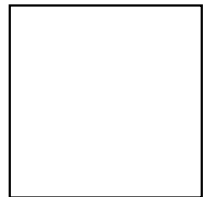
