IAAMJV-USA is a non-profit and tax-exempt organization that was founded in 1991 and has 800+ members. While many of them are the alumni students of Shri Mahavira Jain Vidyalaya in India, it is attracting very strong support from many education loving individuals from the larger Jain community. The association prides itself in promoting professional education in the Jain community in a significant way.

It offers three loan scholarship programs aimed at helping bright and needy students as described below. These opportunities are open to all Jain students, irrespective of their sect or region. All scholarships are in the form of interest free loans. Please donate generously to support the donation schemes described on the other side of this page which are designed to let you preserve your legacy in the names of your loved ones.

Loan Scholarships for Graduate Students from India for Higher Education in the USA (LSGI)

IAAMJV-USA offers loan scholarships of \$5,000 to bright and needy Jain students coming from India for higher studies at graduate/higher study institutions in USA. Depending upon availability of funds, IAAMJV plans to increase the amount of loan to a larger amount, moving forward.

- Total loan scholarships of \$2.15 million have been awarded to 773 students since inception. Out of this, \$1.1 million of loan has been repaid by the students. The year 2023 has been another record-breaking year when IAAMJV extended loans of \$350,000 to a total of 72 students.
- The awardees are expected to return loan scholarships after they start working, and many of them have done so. Some of them have repaid more than the borrowed amount, making extra funds available for future students.

Loan Scholarships to College Students in India (LSUI)

IAAMJV offers loan scholarships or grants ranging from Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 50,000 to bright and needy, Jain undergraduate and graduate college students in India.

- A total of Rs. 1.31 Crores worth loan scholarships / grants have been awarded to 1050 students since inception.
- A total of Rs. 19 Lakhs of loan scholarships / grants were awarded to 63 students in the year 2023.

College Education Loan for Undergraduate or Associate College studies in the USA (CEL)

IAAMJV offers a loan of total \$10,000, spread over 3 to 4 years to undergraduate and associate degree college students. Total of \$392K worth of loan scholarships have been awarded to 79 students since year 2000. Of these, \$183,000 worth of loans have been repaid by the students, enabling expansion of this program.

For the betterment of our community and to preserve our rich heritage and culture, IAAMJV would like to invite you to join in this noble endeavor. By supporting the education of students, your participation will brighten the future of the next generation. We hope that these efforts will enhance the vibrancy of the Jain community as well as our shared global community. IAAMJV-USA Donation Schemes

LSGI Endowment Fund USA (EF USA) for \$50,000:

The interest from this fund is used for the award to finance a LSGI loan scholarship every year under donor's name. IAAMJV-USA uses returned money for new loan awards, expanding number of student beneficiaries.

Gold Patron (GoP) Fund Donation for \$20,000: Under this scheme, every year a LSGI student is given out a loan on the name of the donor. Once the recipient starts returning the loan, the amount is re-circulated for future loan awards under the donors' name.

CEL Fund for \$10,000: A loan scholarship is awarded on the name of the donor to USA based students for undergraduate studies in USA. Once the recipient starts returning the loan amount, the amount is re-circulated in the fund for future loan awards.

Endowment Fund India for \$5,000:

The interest from this fund is used to finance a grant of Rs. 25,000 to a recipient under, often recommended by the donor. The donation is also accepted in India with an amount Rs. 5,00,000 for each Endowment Fund for India.

General Fund: Smaller donations are grouped together and used to give out additional loans in all categories.
