With all the hard work of the current committee, and support from fellow alumni and non-alumni members of IAAMJV, we had a very successful year. As a president, I would first like to



thank all the committee members and all the Alumni members for your continued support for this noble cause of education through supporting IAAMJV. I am very happy to share some of the great news.

India Scholarship team is working hard to expand the scholarship program to benefit more students. The Indian laws and guidelines for operating a charity in India are revised and become more stringent to follow. The scholarship team along with the support of our accountant in India was successful to complete the procedure and activating the FCRA account. Team also completed the Trust Registration. To appreciate their efforts, we felicitated Shri Nautam Vakil with a plaque and shawl and felicitated Dr. Sunil Shah (Chair Person) and Shri Vimal Shah with a shawl.

Historically, we receive about 40 to 50 applications for the LSGI program, however this year we received the highest number of applications. We are ecstatic to announce that we awarded a loan scholarship of \$4,000 to a total of 64 students (between the Fall & Spring semesters) this year!

New Change- Under CEL program, we award a loan scholarship of \$10,000 for undergraduate study in the USA only to students that hold a Green Card or US Citizenship. This year, we expanded the program to include students having any visa (a student visa or any dependent visa).

Additionally, our sub-committee is working on updating the IAAMJV Website and part of the update involves revision of the constitution.

We encourage all members and all alumni to register for the JAINA Convention to be held at Lakewood, Florida to help attend our general body meeting.

We are always looking for volunteers who wish to join and help the organization. New members could start working under sub-committees such as Loan Recovery, IT, Communication, Accounting, etc., and thereby learn more about the work IAAMJV does. I would highly encourage all the CEL & LSGI Recipients as well as other Alumni members to join us. Please contact us if you wish to join our organization.

Once again, thank you all for your continued support and assistance to IAAMJV.

<u>Financial Update</u> – by Vasant Shah and Hitesh C. Shah

IAAMJV has been supporting the transfer of donation amount to SMJV (Shri Mahavira Jain Vidyalaya) for quite some time however, such transfers have grown in the last few years thereby increasing the workload on IAAMJV that includes fees charged by the bank for the transfer. The executive committee has decided to ask donors for an additional 2.5% (minimum) of the donation amount of the actual donation. The additional amount will go to IAAMJV's general funds in supporting our scholarship programs. This change will apply to all education-related charities.

We are pleased to inform you that we have received a total donation of \$255,136 between March 19, 2022, and Oct 23, 2022. Out of this donation, \$138,501 is received for Special Projects for SMJV and other educational institutes. IAAMJV Loan Scholarship Programs & Donation Schemes

IAAMJV runs the following loan scholarship programs and donation schemes. All application material and information for the Loan Scholarship programs are available on the web, IAAMJV.org. The loan scholarship is open for any Jain Student. The student for the award is selected based on a strict selection criteria process. IAAMJV has a few donors in each program and schemes are listed below.

A donor may like to donate (such as in memory of XYZ) and can select the name of Trust / Fund of his or her choice for the donation under GoP & EF USA (both for LSGI program), EF India (LSUI program), or CEL program (for USA Students & Student Visa Holders). A donor can pledge and pay in installments as well. The Trust / Fund will be activated for awards after the full amount is received for the respective fund.

The details of the award including the student's name and Trust / Fund name are published in IAAMJV's March and October Newsletters, as applicable.

IAAMJV is a Non-profit tax-exempt organization in the US under IRS Code Section 501 (c) (3), ID #:11-3097675. The donation in INR in India for Endowment Fund (India) is Tax exempted under 80G. Please contact the President or any Executive Committee Member of IAAMJV for additional information.

A. Loan Scholarship for Graduate Study in USA for Students coming from India (LSGI Program)

This loan is awarded to students enrolled in graduate studies in any US institution. A strict selection criterion is applied to all LSGI applications during the selection process. We budget a loan of \$4,000 each to a total of 40+ students each year, spread between Fall & Spring semesters which is applicable for three LSGI programs described below. With tremendous support from the Jain Community of the USA, we aim to increase the budget for up to about 70 students considering the flow of applications, and increase the amount to \$5,000.

- LSGI Endowment Fund USA (EF USA) for \$50,000: Under this scheme, every year during the fall or spring semester, for each "LSGI Endowment fund USA", a loan award is made to a qualified student in the donor's name. Recipient students as well as donors' names are published in the IAAMJV newsletter. The repayment is merged with the General fund.
- Gold Patron (GoP) Fund Donation for \$16,000: Under this scheme, every year during the fall or spring semester, for each "LSGI Endowment fund USA" a loan award is made to a qualified student in the donor's name. Recipient students as well as donors' names are published in the IAAMJV newsletter. Once the recipient starts returning the loan, the amount is re-circulated for future loan awards under the donor's name.
- **LSGI Loan Scholarship from General Fund:** As required, the Loan scholarship is awarded from the general fund which is built up with the donation received under the general fund.

B. Scholarship for Undergraduate Study in India for Indian Students (LSUI Program)

We award a loan scholarship or a scholarship (from a General Fund or Endowment Trust) of Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 25,000 to 40 to 80 students in India each year. The program is operated through IAAMJV Trust, Amdavad. We are spreading the message on an ongoing basis to the community to expand the program to benefit more



students and also to increase the award amount. The selection of the student is carried out by LSUI selection committee with strict criteria along with a recommendation from the donor.

Endowment Fund India for \$5,000: Under this scheme, every year in September, from the LSUI Endowment Fund India, a scholarship grant is made to a qualified student in the donor's name. The current LSUI scholarship amount is Rs. 25,000 per year during undergraduate and graduate studies, generally between 3-5 years. Recipient students as well as donors' names are published in the IAAMJV newsletter.

For this Endowment Fund India scheme, the donation is also accepted in India in Indian Rupees. For the same, a donation of Rs.5,00,000 is required to open and activate each Endowment Fund. The applications/processing and other terms and conditions will remain the same as above.

C. College Education Loan Scholarship for Undergraduate Studies for US Students (CEL Program)

This loan is awarded to students enrolled in undergraduate or associate degree studies in any US institution. A strict selection criterion is applied to all CEL applications. Each loan amount is \$10,000 spread over 3-4 years. With tremendous support from the Jain Community of the USA, we aim to increase the number of CEL awards available. The recipient is selected by the CEL Committee based on a strict selection process.

• CEL Fund for \$10,000: Under this scheme, every year, in the Fall or Spring semester, for each CEL Fund, a scholarship grant is made to a qualified student in the donor's name. The recipient will receive \$5,000 in the first year, \$3,000 in the second year, and \$2,000 in the third year. A reduced amount of \$5,000 to \$8,000 is awarded if the student applies first time in the third year of study or has two years of study. Recipient students as well as donors' names are published in the IAAMJV newsletter. The loan amount (repayment) is recirculated in the fund for future awards generally after complete repayment.

Scholarships Reports

A. Loan Scholarships to Students from India for Graduate Study in USA (LSGI) - by Arvind Shah & Mahendra Shah

The LSGI Scholarship Committee has awarded Loan Scholarships to 46 students in the Fall 2022 semester, each \$4,000 per student, totaling \$184,000. We are fortunate to award more students than average over the years. Since the inception (since the year 1993) of the LSGI program, we have disbursed a total of \$1,799,000 to 702 students.

Those who graduated are now working and doing very well. We are very fortunate to be in a position to help these students and see them prosper right in front of our eyes. The EC and LSGI committee & volunteers are aggressively working to contact students with outstanding loans. The loan recovery is excellent with a good response. However, we strongly request recipients who graduated before the year 2015 initiate and pay off their loans as early as possible.

B. College Education Loans to Under Graduate US Resident Students (CEL) -Mukesh Shah

Since 2000, CEL has awarded 67 students' interest-free loans. In 2022, (6 new and 8 continuing) students were awarded this loan. The program has 37 sponsors. We thank all donors from the bottom of our heart for supporting this program. This program is open to undergraduate college students over the duration of their undergraduate college enrollment. The CEL team has implemented an online application portal which has simplified the application process. Visit web site https://www.iaamjv.org/ and apply online. Refer CEL FAQs for details.



Since last newsletter to help more needy students, after detail study, CEL program is expanded its loan offering to non-US resident and offer loan to all four-year students in undergraduate program.

Program Name: College Education Loan for Bachelor or Associate degree studies in USA

Amount of Loan:

Bachelor's degree: Total Loan amount of \$5,000 to \$10,000 will be provided over a 3-year period - \$5k, \$3K, \$2K – as long as the student is enrolled in college.

Associate degree: Total Loan amount of \$3,000 - \$5,000 will be provided over a 2-year period - \$3K, \$2K - as long as the student is enrolled in college.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Born in Jain Family or actively practicing Jainism
- Graduating High School Senior and/or student in 2nd to 4th year of college pursuing Bachelor or Associate Degree.
- Enrolled in an academic institute in USA during each year of eligibility
- U.S. Citizen or any valid US visa holder including Green Card
- Need financial assistance

C. Loan Scholarships to Undergraduates Students in India (LSUI)

The LSUI loan scholarship program started in 1993 for Jain students in India for pursuing undergraduate or graduate studies. We continue to receive a large number of applications. Every year (around September), we select about 40 to 80 students depending upon the number of applications received, and award them with loan scholarships/scholarships ranging from Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 50,000 based on their merit and need.

Dr. Sunil Shah, Chair Person, Vimal Shah, and his team, along with his team members (refer to page 2 for India Scholarship Committee) are working hard to increase the number of applications benefiting more students and in turn Jain Families. The loan/scholarship recipients for the current year are listed below. It is to be noted that the student's name, listed with Endowment Fund India (EFI) is awarded a scholarship.
